- January 10 – Monday – Add/Drop
- **January 10 – Monday – Class work begins**
- January 11 – Tuesday – Add/Drop
- January 11 – Tuesday – Last day a student may officially drop a course or cancel registration with the University Registrar for a full refund of fees
- January 17 – Monday – Martin Luther King Birthday – Academic Holiday
- January 19 – Wednesday – Last day to add a class for the 2011 Spring Semester
- January 22 – Saturday – Payment deadline of registration fees and/or housing and dining fees – If total amount due is not paid as indicated on the account statement, a late payment fee of 1.25 percent of the amount past due will be assessed.
  
- February 2 – Wednesday – Last day to change grading option (credit to audit or audit to credit)
- February 2 – Wednesday – Last day to drop a course without it appearing on student's transcript
- February 9 – Wednesday – Last day to officially withdraw from the University or reduce course schedule and receive a 50 percent refund
- February 10 – Thursday – Last day to file an application for a May degree
- February 10 – Thursday – Deadline to apply for Kentucky residency for this semester
- **February 25 – Friday – Last day to withdraw from a course** - Students may withdraw after this date only upon petition to the Dean's office specifying "reasons relating to extended illness or equivalent distress."
  
- March 1 – Tuesday – Last day for submission of application for admission for 2011 Fall Semester
- March 14-19 – Monday through Saturday – Spring Vacation – Academic Holidays
- **March 28-April 19 – Monday through Tuesday – Priority Registration for the 2011 Summer Session and 2011 Fall Semester**
  
- April 22 – Friday – End of class work
- April 23-25 – Saturday through Monday – Law Examination Reading Period
- April 26-May 7 – Tuesday through Saturday – Law Final Examination Period
  
- May 6 – Friday – Law Commencement
