- June 8 – Thursday - Class work begins
- June 8 – Thursday - Last day a student may officially drop a course or cancel registration with the University Registrar for a full refund of fees
- June 9 – Friday - Last day to officially withdraw from the University or reduce course load and receive an 80 percent refund
- June 9 – Friday - Last day to enter an organized class for the 2017 eight week summer session
- June 19 – Monday - Last day to change grading option (credit to audit or audit to credit)
- June 19 – Monday - Last day to drop a course without it appearing on student’s transcript
- June 22 – Thursday - Last day to officially withdraw from the University or reduce course schedule and receive a 50 percent refund
- June 23 – Friday - Last day to file an application for an August degree
- June 21 – Tuesday - Payment Deadline

July

- July 4 – Tuesday - Independence Day - Academic Holiday
- July 5 – Wednesday - Last day to withdraw from a course. Students may withdraw after this date only upon petition to the Dean’s office specifying “reasons relating to extended illness or equivalent distress.”
- July 28 – Friday - End of class work
- July 29 and 30 – Saturday and Sunday - Law Examination Reading Period
- July 31 – August 3 – Monday through Thursday - Law Final Examination Period

August

- August 3 – Thursday - End of 2017 Summer Session
